OBEDIENCE RULES AND REGULATIONS

These Rules and Regulations are to be read in conjunction with The Kennel Club Obedience Show Regulations G under which this show is licensed. It is the responsibility of everyone entering this show to make themselves familiar with the Kennel Club G Regulations, available from the Kennel Club.

1. Dogs entered at Kennel Club licensed Obedience Shows must be registered at the Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club Regulations for Classification and Registration B.
2. All dogs registered and resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the Show/Event can be made. All overseas entries without a Kennel Club Registration Number or an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
3. Puppies under six calendar months of age on the day of the Show are not eligible to compete in Kennel Club licensed Obedience Shows
4. Not for competition entries will be accepted for dogs aged 4 calendar months and over. Dogs must be Kennel Club registered with their details recorded on the entry form. There is no entry fee.
5. The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries.
6. In the event that the show is cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances, the club will refund fees, less reasonable incurred expenses, on receipt of a stamped addressed envelope submitted within 1 month of the show date.
7. In classes without a full running order dogs will be received until one hour after the commencement of Judging at 8.30am after which no dogs may be received except under unforeseen and exceptional circumstances and by special permission of the Show Management.
8. For the duration of the show all dogs, including those in the exercise area, must be on a lead except when competing or practicing prior to competition.
9. Animals in Event.
No animal, other than one officially entered, shall be brought into the precincts of the event during its continuance, except any dogs registered to assist the disabled, or dogs required for educational or instructional purposes or by permission of the General Committee.
However, at the discretion of the show society, a dog brought to the show by a spectator may be admitted into the precincts of the dog show, with the proviso that those in charge of the dog sign a declaration confirming the dog is free from disease and that the dog will be kept under proper control at all times
10. A dog shall be disqualified and removed from the Show if it is:
 - a bitch which is in season;
 - suffering from any infectious or contagious diseases;
 - interfering with the safety or chance of winning of an opponent;
 - of such a temperament or is so much out of hand to be a danger to the safety of any person or animal; or
 - likely to cause suffering to the dog if it continues competing.
11. No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time within the boundaries of the Show, which includes the car park and exercise areas.
12. No competitor shall impugn the decision of the judge or judges.
13. Should a judge be unable to fulfil the appointment to judge the Committee reserves the right to appoint another judge.
14. Should circumstances dictate, the Club, in consultation with the judges, may alter the arrangements as necessary. Any changes and the circumstances surrounding them will be reported to the Kennel Club.
15. There is no prize money.
16. **DOGS IN CARS ON HOT DAYS**
Your dog is vulnerable and AT RISK if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered as slightly warm. Please take care of your dog. If your dog is found to be at risk forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.
17. **Welfare of Dogs-** A competitor whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licenced event should take reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not knowingly put their dogs' health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this regulation may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations



DEFINITION OF OBEDIENCE CLASSES

1. In the following definitions of Classes First Prize wins in Limited Show Obedience Classes and Open Shows confined to one breed do not count for entry in Open and Championship Obedience Classes but do count for eligibility at Limited Obedience Shows or Open Shows confined to one breed.
2. A dog must be entered in the lowest scheduled class for which it is eligible and may also be entered in another class if desired, one Special Class excepted.
Exemptions from this regulation are:- A dog entered in a Good Citizen Dog Scheme Special Pre-Beginner Obedience Stakes Class or a Young Kennel Club (YKC) Obedience Class which may also be entered in a maximum of two other scheduled classes (including YKC classes) for which it is eligible.
3. Societies may schedule classes other than those defined below. The eligibility for "Special" classes must be defined by the Society and included in the schedule. The word "Special" must be included in the title of the class.

PRE-BEGINNERS	To compete in Pre-beginners a handler or dog must not have won a first prize in Pre-beginners or gained a third place or above in any other obedience class.
BEGINNERS	To compete in Beginners a handler or dog must not have won a total of two or more first prizes in Beginners Class or one first prize in any other obedience class. (Pre-beginners excepted.)
NOVICE	For dogs that have not won two first prizes in obedience classes. (Pre-beginners and Beginners excepted).
CLASS A	For dogs that have not won three first prizes in Class A, B and Open C in total.
CLASS B	For dogs that have not won three first prizes in Class B and Open C in total.
OPEN CLASS C	Open to all dogs.

YKC CRUFTS QUALIFIER OBEDIENCE

All handlers must be a fully paid up member of the YKC before entering a YKC Obedience competition.

Only dogs of 6 calendar months of age and over on the day of competition are eligible for entry into a YKC qualifying obedience class.

Please note that dogs must be of 8 calendar months of age and over on the day of competition into the Crufts finals in YKC ring.

The class winner (provided he/she is within qualifying marks) will automatically qualify for the same class at Crufts. If he/she wins the same class more than once in the qualifying year, he/she will remain in that class. If he/she should win a higher class in the qualifying year, he/she will be entered into the higher class at Crufts.

Members must be aged 6-24 years (for members 6 years and up to, but not including 25th birthday).

Eligibility:

Starters; A handler or dog must not have won a first prize in any YKC obedience class within qualifying marks or won a first prize in Pre-beginners or Beginners class held at a KC Licensed Event, Open or Championship Obedience show.

Elementary; A handler or dog must not have won two or more first prize in any YKC obedience class (starters exempt) within qualifying marks or won a first prize in Beginners (Pre-beginners exempt) or any other Obedience class held at a KC Licensed Event, Open or Championship Obedience show.

Graduate; For dogs that have not won three or more first prizes in a YKC obedience class (Starters and Elementary exempt) within qualifying marks or won three or more first prizes in any Obedience class (Pre-beginners and Beginners exempt) held at a KC Licensed Event, Open or Championship Obedience show.

Intermediate; For dogs that have not won three or more first prizes in a YKC Intermediate or Advanced class within qualifying marks or have won three or more first prizes in Class A or above in an Obedience class held at a KC Licensed Event, Open or Championship Obedience show.

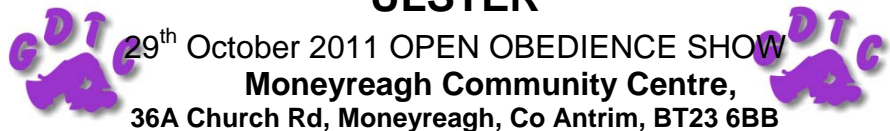
Advanced; For dogs that have not gained a first place in 'C' at an Open or Championship Obedience show. CC & Reserve CC Obedience winners will not be able to compete at Crufts.

A puppy under six months old cannot be exhibited. On no account will entries be accepted without fees.
